Cruceros Australis is a small expedition cruise company that navigates in one of the most virgin territories on earth: the Chilean and Argentine Patagonia and Tierra del Fuego.

Cruceros Australis runs two programmes, one of three nights from Ushuaia (Argentina) to Punta Arenas (Chile), and one of four nights from Punta Arenas to Ushuaia.

In both routes the vessels reach Cape Horn, the southernmost point of land before Antarctica. The cruises navigate the Beagle Channel and the Magellan Strait, an uninhabited place where it is really hard to see any other human being, but where one can see lots of wildlife.

The route is covered by the M/V Mare and Via Australis, which are twin ships, with 64 cabins and space for 131/136 passengers respectively.

Starting in mid-December, the M/V Mare Australis will be replaced by the brand new M/V Stella Australis, with capacity for 210 passengers in 100 cabins.
