

Faralya, Turkey

Faralya is a hamlet in south-west Turkey, approximately 80 km (50 miles) south-east of the international airport at Dalaman.

It is 3 km from the Butterfly Valley, and within easy reach of beaches that range from rocky coves for snorkelling to sandy bays. Faralya is also 9 km (6 miles) from the popular beach resort of Oludeniz, and 21 km (13 miles) from the harbour town of Fethiye.

The area has a number of archaeological sites - including Tlos, Pinara, Xanthos, Letoon and Kadyanda.

Bear viewing

Alaska has black bears and brown/grizzly bears, and it is not unusual to see either species along the highway or even in the cities, but for guaranteed bear viewing, visitors need to go with the experts.

The Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center offers close-up views of grizzly bears.

Glacier viewing




