New Mexico ghost towns

New Mexico's mining history and cowboy heritage has left over 400 ghost towns scattered across the state including :

Shakespeare

Shakespeare is located just outside the city of Lordsburg, near the Arizona border.

In addition to the town's regular tours there are seven living history re-enactment shows, including 'Death over an Egg' where Ross Woods was shot and killed in the dining room of the Stratford Hotel by Bean Belly Smith.



Dawson

In 1901 Dawson coal mine opened, but by 1950 the whole town was deserted due to several mining explosions that resulted in the death of over 350 miners. In its heyday Dawson, which is located in north east New Mexico, had its own newspaper, a theatre, hotel, hospital, golf course and bowling alley.

The town now stands empty and visitors are left with the memories of those who lost their lives and whose graves are marked by a single white cross.

Lake Valley

Lake Valley Ghost Town is ocated by the western side of Monument Peak, north west of Las Cruces. Once an old ore mining town with a reputation for being a tough cowboy haunt, today visitors can explore the old buildings and the restored school house.

Steins

Steins, an old railroad town, was named after Captain Enoch Stein, a US army officer. During the late 1800s and early 1900s a number of rail tracks were built through the town and today it is one of the most well preserved ghost towns.

Located in the south western corner of New Mexico, Steins still has its period furnishings so visitors really can take a step back in time and see how a western town really used to look.

Yeso

Yeso, which is located in the centre of El Grande, is an old trading centre for ranchers and farmers in the area. When it became clear that the land surrounding Yeso was no good to farmers many of them left, leaving behind the empty shells of family homes, a motel, garage and local shop.

Fort Jesus, Mombasa

The historic site of Fort Jesus in Mombasa has been awarded UNESCO World Heritage Site status.

Mombasa, the largest city in Kenya, is the gateway to a 500km stretch of Indian Ocean coastline and Fort Jesus is one of its key attractions

In East Africa's oldest harbour, the fort was built by the Portuguese in the 16th century to protect the port of Mombasa and represents an outstanding example of Portuguese military fortification of the period.

It served as a transit point for the slave trade and commodities and it attracted traders from Portugal, India and the Middle East.

Fort Jesus will become the sixth World Heritage Site in Kenya on a list which includes the Lamu Archipelago to the north of Kenya's coast, Lake Bogoria, Lake Nakuru, Lake Elementaita and the Great Rift Valley.

Mombasa's Old Town has also been put forward to UNESCO for consideration.

Europe's unusual delicacies

Rail Europe has uncovered some of Europe's more unusual dishes in some of its destinations throughout Europe.

Casu Marzu, Sardinia, Italy

Casu Marzu is an overripe, maggot-infested cheese is something of an Italian delicacy. The cheese starts off life as a simple Pecorino before being left in the sun in a bid to tempt flies to lay their eggs inside it.

Tripe Stew, Porto, Portugal

A pungent, smoky stew of white beans and tripe is a staple of most bars and restaurants in this buzzing port city on the River Douro.

Andouillette sausage, Troyes, France

This is a pale, lumpy sausage made from pigs' intestines.

Goose Barnacles, Galicia, Spain

Goose barnacles are tiny crustaceans that can only be harvested along northern Spain's rugged coastline.

Smalahove, Norway

Take one sheep's head, torch the wool off it and remove the brain, salt and smoke the head then steam or boil it for a few hours.

Cholera, Valais, Switzerland

The Valais region of Switzerland produces a dish of potatoes, leeks, cheese, onions, apples, pears and bacon are topped with pastry and baked.

Navada's state parks

While two thirds of Navad's population live in the Las Vegas area its state parks offer deserts and snow-capped mountain ranges.

During late summer and early autumn visitors are able to experience dramatic natural scenery and wildlife as the temperature begins to cool ahead of the winter season.

Great Basin

A vast, high-altitude mountain desert with impressive rock precipices and towering mountain ranges, the Western edge of the Great Basin provides a destination for avid stargazers.

Isolated from nearby towns and cities, the absence of light pollution provides a crystal clear night sky. This autumn's highlight is the Orionids meteor showers in October.



Beaver Dam State

As eastern Nevada's most remote park, Beaver Dam State is located six miles north of the town of Caliente, and offers deep canyons and thick pine and juniper forests, which are home to a series of beaver dams built into the stream running through the park.

Valley of Fire State Park

Situated 55 miles northeast of Las Vegas, Valley of Fire State Park is the oldest and largest state park in Nevada. The parks vivid red landscape comes from the red sandstone formations that rise out of the Mojave Desert.

The park is popular with photographers due to its alien terrain, strong light and unique rock formations.

Fort Churchill

Fort Churchill, a US. Army fort built in 1860, provided protection for early settlers. It survived only nine years before it was abandoned, although visitors to the park can still see its remains today.

A former route of The Pony Express and the Overland Telegraph, this thoroughfare now provides a visitor centre with historical artefacts.

Lake Tahoe Nevada State Park

Lake Tahoe Nevada State Park is home to Sand Harbor and Incline Village.

The Tahoe Adventure Company hosts a range of land and water-based itineraries and trips for individuals, groups and families.
