# Benidorm, Spain

The Spanish coastal town of Benidorm was transformed from a sleepy village to a bustling tourist centre during the 1960s.

Each summer, the population of Benidorm swells to over 1.5 million people with visitors from throughout Europe.

The major attractions of Benidorm are its sandy beaches and the lively nightlife, with over 30 nightclubs and 1,000 restaurants ready to enjoy.



Other Benidorm attractions include the Casco Antiguo (the old Benidorm city centre), Terra Mitica theme park, Terra Natura animal park, Mundomar Park and Aqualandia Water Park. For golf lovers, there are few top class golf courses in and around Benidorm.

# Albufeira

Situated on the south coast of Portugal, Albufeira's popularity boomed in the late 1960s, welcoming visitors from all over the world.

Albufeira is known for its old worldly charm around the Fisherman's beach area, with its labyrinth of narrow streets, whitewashed houses and cafes which lead to the central square. Yet also there is a new part of Albufeira, which is centered around 'The Strip', a lively hub of activity with a beautiful beach.

During the warm summer evenings, the restaurants, bars and clubs fill up with people, until they spill over into the vibrant streets. A new Marina has been completed on the west side of the town and offers a different and attractive aspect to the resort.

# Kos

Kos sits in the middle of the Dodecanese chain of Greek islands that hug the Turkish coastline between Rhodes and Patmos.

It was one of the first Greek islands to go for mass-market tourism in a big way, with many Kos hotels built on beaches along the long, sandy coastlines to the east and south.

Kos, unlike many other Greek islands, is mostly flat and low-lying. The lack of hills has helped to make cycling a very popular Kos holiday activity and there are many bicycle rental outlets on the island. As well as the nightlife of Kos Town and a plethora of beach resorts, Kos also offers the discerning tourist some of the best archaeological sites in the Mediterranean.

# **Bike Rides in New York and New England**

Great Freedom Adventures has outlined five favorite bike rides in New York's Hudson Valley and in New England.

#### **Covered Bridges of East Central Vermont**

This is a scenic 31.3 mile loop that starts and finishes in historic Woodstock, a town the *Ladies Home Journal* termed "one of the prettiest small towns in America." The route passes picture-perfect farmland, a dramatic gorge, classic country stores, a blueberry farm, three covered bridges, art galleries, restaurants and delis, and unique shops.

#### Islesboro, Maine

A 14-mile-long island in Maine's upper Penobscot Bay is accessed by ferry from Lincolnville on the mainland. In the 19<sup>th</sup> century home to the largest commercial shipping fleet, the island was later reborn as a Gilded Age resort community with many large summer homes remaining.

A 28.5-mile-ride begins and ends at the Isleboro ferry landing, along the way passing many harbors and coves filled with lobster pots and the famous summer colony and yachting center at Dark Harbor.



# Vineyards and Horse Farms of the Hudson Valley

A 21.8-mile route traverses a tranquil countryside of impeccably manicured horse farms, stately homes and fragrant vineyards. The ride is begins and ends in Millbrook, a picturesque village and antique mecca. Cyclists pass Oak Summit Vineyards where you can stop to sample the vintages.

#### **Ride the Gaps of West Central Vermont**

A 48-mile Green Mountain National Forest expedition begins and ends in Branbury State Park on the east side of Lake Dunsmore, with extraordinary wilderness in the Moosalamoo Recreation Area and a chance for a dip in the lake at the end.

#### Maritime Massachusetts

A 40.5-mile, scenic ride blends ocean breezes with colonial homes and farms, historic villages, dramatic shoreline and gorgeous beaches. Views of lighthouses and boat-filled harbors abound. Along the way are plentiful eateries including clam shacks, a boat building museum, sea captains' mansions, and numerous antique shops and boutiques.

Orient-Express is to open Palacio Nazarenas, a 55 suite hotel in a former palace and convent in Cuzco, Peru in early summer 2012.

It will be the groups sixth hotel in Peru and, when opened, will be the culmination of a three year restoration project carried out under the guidance of eight full time archaeologists and the supervision of Peru's National Institute of Culture (INC).

Cuzco is located 11,000 feet above sea level in the Andes mountain range. To combat the symptoms of altitude sickness, which sometimes include sleeplessness and headaches, oxygen delicately scented with healing essential aromas of Andean flowers and herbs will enrich the atmosphere of each suite via the ventilation system, enabling guests to build up a reserve in their bloodstream as they slumber.

Cuzco is an ancient Inca capital and gateway to one of the great wonders of the world, the citadel of Machu Picchu, which is three hours away by Orient-Express' Hiram Bingham train through the magnificent Sacred Valley.

Palacio Nazarenas will become the sister property to Hotel Monasterio, a 126 room former 16<sup>th</sup> century monastery owned and operated by Orient-Express since March 1999.
