Since 1968 the Sherlock Holmes Society of London has organised pilgrimages to Switzerland's Bernese Oberland region to pay homage to their hero.

Although Holmes is more often associated with London, one memorable story, "The Final Problem", sees him travel to Switzerland where he falls to his death at the Reichenbach Falls near Meiringen.

Sherlock Holmes author, Arthur Conan Doyle visited Switzerland along with many other great writers, artists and composers. Drawn by the natural beauty, the Byron, Turner, Tolkien, Goethe and Mendelssohn all visited the Bernese Oberland during the 19th and 20th centuries.

From 9 to 16 September, fans from around the world will recreate a typical "Grand Tour" itinerary to the area. Dressed in period costume they will relive the Golden Age of European travel, art and literature.

Keats House, London

Poet John Keats lived in this house with his friend Charles Brown from 1818 to 1820, and this is the setting that inspired some of Keats' most memorable poetry.

Here, Keats wrote 'Ode to a Nightingale', while sitting under a plum tree in the garden; he fell in love with Fanny Brawne, the girl next door.

It was from this house that he travelled to Rome, where he died of tuberculosis aged just 25. The Heath Branch Public Library occupies the space where various outhouses once stood.

The library was opened on 16 July 1931, and displays some artefacts from the house, including the engagement ring Keats offered to Fanny Brawne and a copy of Keats' death mask.

The ghost town of Rhyolite

The secluded Rhyolite is classed as one of the best ghost towns in America.

Situated on the eastern edge of Death Valley, a visit gives the chance to learn about the past of this once-booming town.

Rhyolite was established in 1905 as a mining town during the gold rush but was abandoned in 1920.

Since this time, no one has lived in the town. The general store, train station and bank still stand in the derelict town, but the most fascinating feature is the jail, where visitors can look out through the metal bars and put themselves in the shoes of past prisoners.



Rachel, the UFO Capital of the World

Located along the Extraterrestrial Highway, approximately 150 miles north of Las Vegas, this small town with just 100 inhabitants is a regular location for fans of UFO's stopping over to learn about the peculiar Air Force testing facility.
