Press trips to events in Tenerife 2012

Tenerife, the largest island in the Canaries stages an annual programme of events including:

Tenerife Carnival, Santa Cruz

15 to 26 February 2012

The carnival in Tenerife, the world's second largest of its kind, includes street parades, live musical performances, dance acts and a street carnival.

Festival of Tegueste, Tegueste

28 and 29 April 2012

Marking the start of Tenerife's religious festival period, the Festival of Tegueste sees thousands of people dress in traditional costume to honour of Saint Mark the Evangelist.

During the event, dozens of colourfully-decorated floats parade down the streets of the village accompanied by singing and dancing groups, while local people hand out potatoes, gofio, meat, eggs and wine from the area in order to symbolise friendship.

Rock Coast Festival, Santa Cruz

24 to 26 May 2012

The island's capital, Santa Cruz, hosts rock concerts and activities.

Corpus Christi Carpets, La Orotava

14 June 2012

Corpus Christi is one of Tenerife's most popular religious festivals, centred around vast intricate and coloured carpets created from flower petals and volcanic sands – which are laid out in the streets.

Perseid Meteor Shower, Teide National Park

12 August 2012

The Perseid Meteor Shower sees more than 60 shooting stars shooting across the sky every hour, caused by tiny particles of debris from a comet burning up when entering the Earth's atmosphere.

Tenerife offers good conditions for star spotting, especially at Mount Teide, Spain's tallest mountain, where there is low light pollution and extraordinarily clear dark skies.

This year, the bulk of activity is expected during the early hours of 12 August 2012.

Icy Strait Point

Icy Strait Point is celebrating the 100th anniversary of the Hoonah Packing Company and its original fishing cannery.

The cannery was the economic engine of the Tlingit village of Hoonah from 1912 until 1953.

With the disappearance of the logging industry and the continued decline of commercial fishing, the village faced economic peril until 1998, when Huna Totem Corporation bought the abandoned cannery facilities and the surrounding land.

Restoration of the salmon cannery began in 2001 and Icy Strait Point opened there in May 2004.

Fort Myers beach, Florida

Fort Myers Beach is located along a thin strip of barrier island on the Gulf of Mexico, in South West Florida.

It is a real tourist trap, attracting those families and young people searching for sun, sea, sand and the 'Coney Island' style excitement of the Times Square dining and entertainment district.

And even while the focus is invariably on the fun side of a sunshine holiday, those looking for something a little more exclusive can take the short drive to Lovers Key state park, where a tractor-pulled tram runs through a mangrove forest to one of Florida's most pristine stretches of sand.

Alternatively a short trip over the causeway and one is on the barrier islands of Sanibel and Captiva.

Finally, for a cultural experience head to downtown Fort Myers, which has enjoyed a remarkable artistic renaissance in recent years.
