VisitBritain – 'Delivering a golden legacy'

VisitBritain, the UK's national tourism agency, has launched a consultation on a growth strategy for inbound tourism to Britain to 2020.

The aim is to be attracting 40 million visitors by 2020, a 3% year on year increase.

The strategy, which looks to build on the showcasing of Britain around the world during the London 2012 Games, sets out four key elements:

Enhancing Britain's image : by playing to Britain's strengths – heritage, traditional and contemporary culture – and addressing perceived weaknesses such as natural beauty, food, value and welcome;

Ensuring Britain is on the shelf : by working with the travel trade in key markets to ensure Britain is packaged and sold;

Building on Britain's strong product : by looking to ensure that destinations can be easily packaged and that Britain continues to meet the expectations of new visitors from growth markets; and

Making it easier to get to the UK : by addressing barriers to growth such as aviation capacity and the visa regime.

UNESCO heritage site in Vietnam's capital to become a cultural park

Thang Long Imperial Citadel in Hanoi is set to be transformed into a cultural and historical park.

The park will cover 45,000sq m including more than 13,000sq m of archeological remains which will be preserved under glass and visible to tourist.

Recognised as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 2010, the Thang Long Imperial Citadel was first discovered in late 2002 during excavation work.

It was part of a citadel system built in the 11th century that included the Dai La Citadel, which acted as a defensive rampart; and the Forbidden City, where the king and his royal family lived.

Since its excavation, scientists have unearthed vestiges from the Ly, Tran, Le and Nguyen dynasties and date back as far as the seventh century.

They have also found many objects from the period between the 7th and 9th centuries, when Chinese colonisers ruled Vietnam.

Grenada

The Caribbean island of Grenada offers a number of feature opportunities including :

Gouyave Fish Fridays

In the northwest part of the island, Kirani's hometown of Gouyave is known for this weekly event, when music, dance and fresh seafood are the center pieces of a street party.

The Grand Etang National Park

Hikers and trekkers can walk the trails along the rainforested slopes of the Park's central mountains, which has lush flora and fauna, a large crater lake and a variety of wildlife from the Mona monkey to the Antillean crested hummingbird.

The National Museum

Built by the French in 1704 and part of the foundations of the Fort George complex, the museum displays Grenada's historic artifacts and exhibits.

Mt. Hartman Dove Sanctuary

Not far from Woburn Bay, this sanctuary is the home of the protected Grenada Dove. Visitors can learn about the bird, which is unique to Grenada and lives in a dry thorn scrub ecosystem.

Belmont Estate

This estate of 400 acres of lush rolling hills in the north of Grenadthe is a 300-year-old working plantation.



Gouyave Nutmeg Processing Station

Grenada is the second largest producer of nutmegs, accounting for about 1/3 of the world's supply. Visitors can tour one of the island's largest nutmeg factories and watch the workers select, grade and package the nutmegs.

Loch Lomond, Scotland

Loch Lomond is the largest loch in Great Britain by surface area and the second largest (after Loch Ness) by water volume.

Loch Lomond contains many islands, including Inchmurrin, the largest fresh-water island in the British Isles.

The loch is 39 kilometres (24 m) long and a maximum depth of about 190 metres (620 ft). Another of the loch's islands, Inchconnachan is home to a colony of wallaby.

Ben Lomond is the most southerly of Scotland's Munros On a clear day, it is visible from the higher grounds of Glasgow and eastwards across the low-lying central valley of Scotland; this may have led to it being named 'Beacon Mountain', as with the equally far-seen Lomond Hills in Fife.

Ben Lomond summit can also be seen from Ben Nevis, the highest peak in Britain, over 70 miles (110 km) away.

Ben Lomond may host the most southerly breeding ptarmigan population in Scotland.

Autumn walking in Loch Lomond

The Love Loch Lomond area has three of Scotland's Great Trails.

Three Lochs Way

Linking towns and villages on the west side of Loch Lomond between Balloch and Inveruglas, the Three Lochs Way is a varied, scenic and generally low-level 52 kilometre (32.3miles) route which can easily be walked in three to four days.

The route also offers lots of attractive and interesting options for people seeking shorter day walks and with some great downhill sections, mountain bikers are sure to enjoy the Three Lochs Way too. Total ascent over the whole route is approximately 900 metres.


